THE CURRENT SEASON

POLITICAL

(From Jesus and Powers, N.T. Wright, Chapter 6)

 Totalitarianism — (1) Fascist-like regimes which weaponize grievances, valorize (give value to) militarism, play on ethnic prejudices and believe that all the nation's problems can be solved by a demagogue carrying a big stick. (2) A form of far-right authoritarian ultra-nationalism characterized by dictatorial power and forcible suppression of any opposition, with a strict regimentation of society and government regulation of the economy.



- Christian Nationalism Government enforcement of Christian hegemony (supremacy) combined with civil religion (a cultural and outward version of Christianity). Christians are given special privileges by the State and Christianity becomes an outward display of patriotic devotion rather than part of a true religious affection.
- Civic totalism Basically the activist progressive left. Wedded to moral absolutes not based on the Bible; "binary slots" of either oppressor or oppressed. Using the civic state to impose progressive values.

RELIGIOUS

Christian Nationalism

- ◆ An attempt to use the Scripture to justify their form of a Christian nation.
- Fear being overwhelmed by social forces and racial demographics.

White Evangelicalism

- ♦ With the decline of Christendom, this group feels marginalized from the culture.
- ♦ Therefore, they can jettison previously held "Biblical" positions regarding candidates' qualifications and policy prescriptions.
- Wedded to the Republican party.

• New Apostolic Reformation (NAR)

- God speaks through modern-day apostles and prophets.
- ♦ Demonic forces can control not only individuals, but entire territories and institutions.
- Church is not so much a place as an active "army of God," one with a holy mission to claim the Earth for the Kingdom as humanity barrels ever deeper into the End Times.
- ♦ Anti-democratic.

Catholic Monarchy

♦ Call for the emergence of a catholic king.

SOCIAL

- Chaotic
- Divisive
- Breaking of norms and traditions
- Growing divide between the "haves" and the "Have Nots"

What Underlies The Headlines? Bad Theology—→False And Counterfeit Gospels

PEOPLE OF COLOR

- Wounded by most recent election results
- Fear, anxiety, anger, resentment, "othering"
- Resignation
- Represents a continuing backlash against people of color blaming
 - ♦ DEI, "wokeness"
 - ♦ Influx of immigrants
 - Poor economic conditions among certain classes.



- **Gospel** Privatized = robbed of any social, political, economic implications.
- Kingdom To be ushered in by human means, not the supernatural power of God.
- Power Used like the Gentiles Luke 22: 24-25
- Cross Emptied of its power 1 Corinthians 1:17-18

HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE ON BIBLICAL RESPONSES TO EVIL (OLD TESTAMENT)

- Abraham Co-exists and fights when necessary (Genesis 12:10-20; Genesis 14)
- Moses Confronts political authority (Exodus 5:1)
- Prophets Confront God's People Isaiah, Hosea, Micah
- ◆ Limited voice to other nations Amos, Habakkuk
- ◆ Jeremiah considered "a traitor"
- Daniel, Nehemiah collaborate

HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE ON BIBLICAL RESPONSES TO EVIL (NEW TESTAMENT)

- Jesus' Contemporaries' Response to Roman oppression:
 - Purify: Scribes and Pharisees Israel wasn't faithful to Torah, so purify.
 - Revolution: Zealots Freedom Fighters
 - ♦ Collaborate: Sadducees Cooperate with Romans and become power brokers
 - ♦ <u>Separate:</u> Essenes Withdrew into their own strict observance of the Torah and held property in common. Waited for God to use them to start a new Israel.
 - Resignation (with underlying resentment): the general population.
- Jesus Resistance AND Submission
 - Resistance to religious authority Matthew 23: 27-26
 - Submission to political authority
 - To Rome Pay taxes Mark 12: 13-17
 - To Pilate at Trial John 19
- Paul Submission with qualifications Acts 16-17; Rom. 13
 - Submission Imprisoned by authorities.
 - Resistance Imprisoned for sharing the gospel and the chaos surrounding its impact.
 - ♦ Converts Roman soldiers and people of influence
- The Church persecuted until it wasn't.




RESPONSE OF THE CONTEMPORARY CHURCH

- Vacillate between:
 - Malcolm (pre-conversion to Orthodox Islam) "A black man has the right to do whatever is necessary to get his freedom. We will never get it by nonviolence." (Liberation – Feb. 1965)
 - ◆ Martin L. King, Jr. "Do to us what you will and we will still love you. ... WE will soon wear you down by our capacity to suffer." (Stride Toward Freedom, 1958)
- Marriage to one political party
- Dependance on human resources
- Righteousness defined as...
 - Personal holiness. Or...
 - Social justice and personal freedom

A BIBLICAL RESPONSE # THE CHURCH

- Offer an alternative community along with a counter-cultural response to evil.
- Offer a Biblical response based on:
 - ♦ Who God says I am
 - ♦ What God says I am to do
- All three responses MUST work in conjunction with the other or each alone with fall into danger zones.
- The Holy Spirit must guide any response giving wisdom as to when and how and what.



- Alive from the dead Eph 2: 1-10
- Aliens and Strangers Hebrews 11:13 and 1 Peter 2:11
- Abhorrent to this world John 15: 18-19
- Ambassadors 2 Corinthians 5: 16-20

BE THE CHURCH

- Be Holy
- Offer an alternative by:
 - Loving your enemy; forgiving; blessing those who curse you
 - ♦ Offering generous community
 - Doing good works
 - ♦ Being joyful.





SPEAK THE TRUTH

Confront the lies.

- Preach the full gospel
 - ♦ The coming Kingdom
 - ♦ Both the now and not yet
- Confront the lies about God, Jesus, the Gospel, the cross and power
- Dissent (Advocate, negotiate, engage in political, social discussion)
- Personally Preach and teach, write, not the headlines but the spiritual forces animating the headlines.



LIVE THE CROSS

Be willing to suffer.



- ♦ Pray AND protest Non-Violent resistance
- ♦ Sacred subversion undermine the powers by forgiving, returning hate with love, serving those unlike you, discovering the image of God in each person.
- Defend self and others
- Uncivil disobedience
 - Using violence, taking up arms (Example: Dietrich Bonhoeffer conspired to assassinate Adolph Hitler
- Be willing to suffer.


